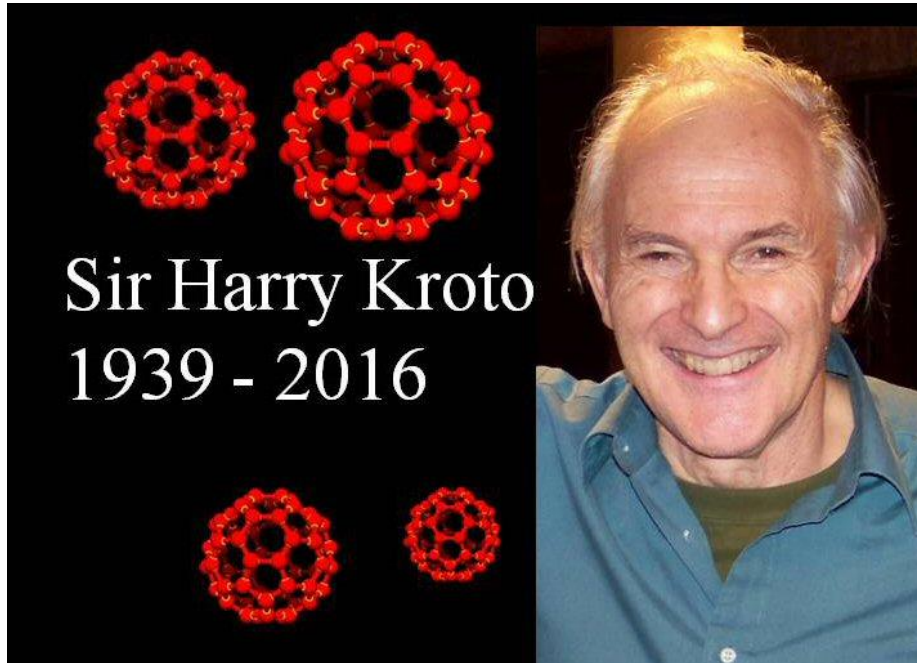


Kroto Science



Sir Harry Kroto was an inspirational and brilliant research scientist working creatively in such diverse areas as chemistry, astronomy, physics, spectroscopy as well as developing multimedia platforms such as the Vega Science Trust and GEOset. He opened up new areas of nanotechnology and of course is best remembered for the discovery of C_{60} Buckminsterfullerene. In 1996 he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Chemistry.
