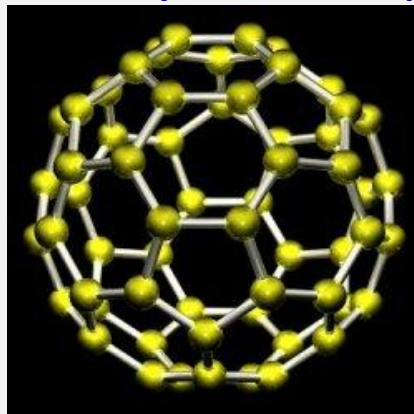
WORKSHOPS
